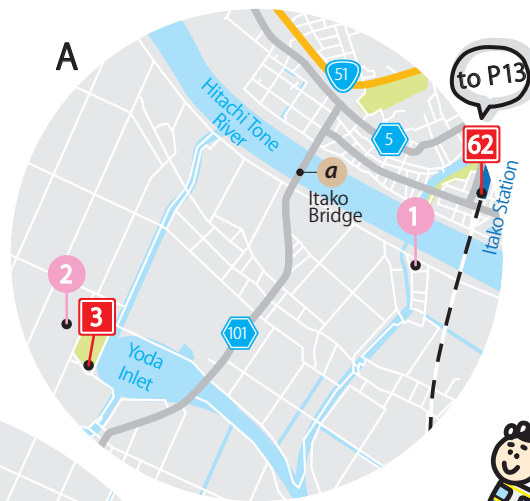
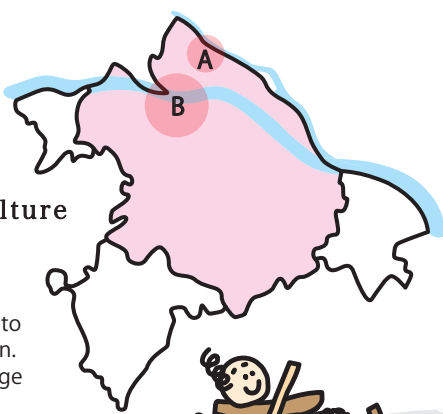


Katori City

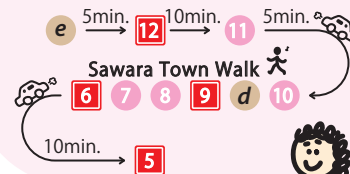
