A town colored by Nature, History and Culture

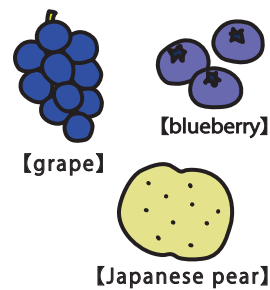

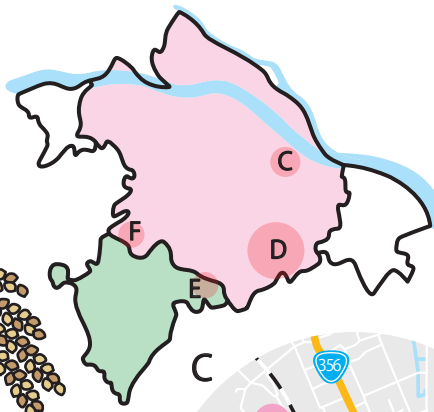
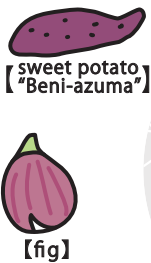
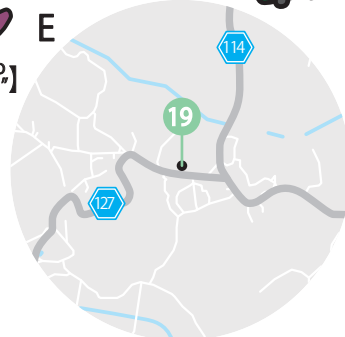
16 Giant camphor tree in Fuma

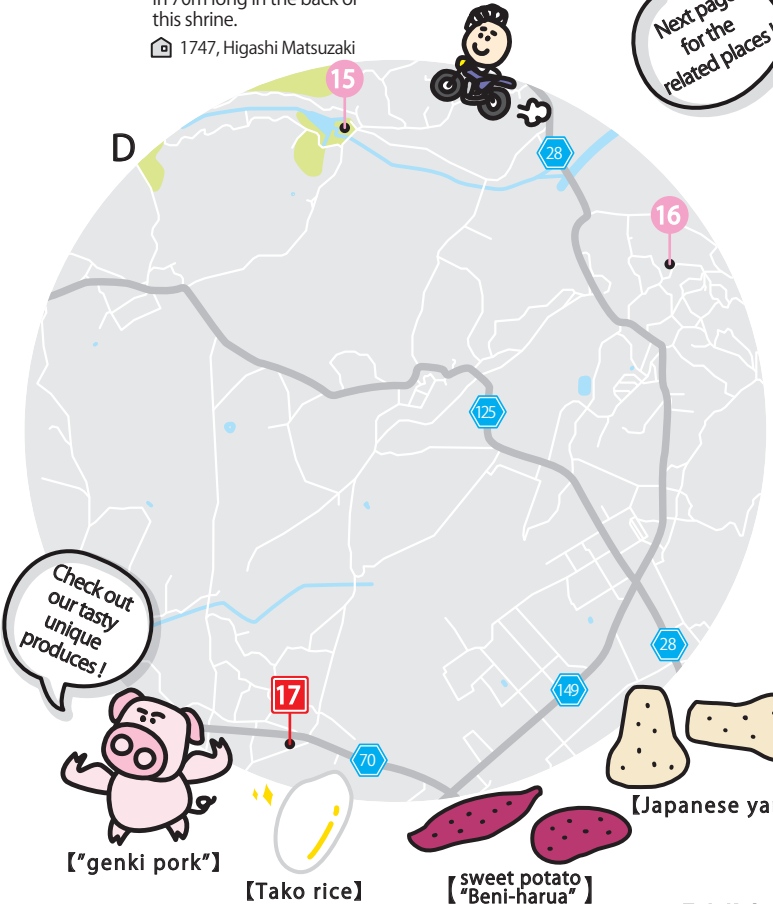
Head family of Chiba clan ended its history here

In mid Muromachi period, the internal conflict of Chiba clan intensified. Makuwari Yasutane, the uncle of Chiba Tanenao, tried to take over clan's leadership by a surprise attack against Tanenao's Inohana-jo castle. Tanenao escaped to Shima-jo castle and his son, Tanenobu escaped to Tako-jo castle. Eventually, assaults led to the fall of Tako-jo castle - the history of Chiba clan's head family came to an end.

19 Matsuzaki shrine / Hojozuka Tumulus
There is a mythic story with the ginkgo tree in shrine that grew from the cane of high priest Kukai. There is Hojozuka tumulus in 70m long in the back of this shrine.
