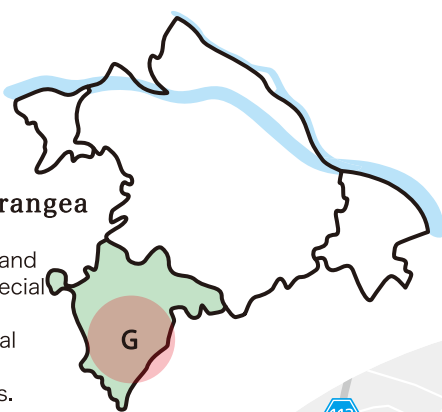


Tako Town

 Stamp Points



20 Koshin Elementary School building
The school was established in 1881 with 2-story wooden building. Now it is often used to shoot TV dramas and movies. Contact Tako town Community Plaza to visit and see inside.

21 Tozen-ji Temple
There is a golin-pagoda for commemorating the head family of Chiba-clan, with Chiba Tanenao and Tanenobu.

22 Shibuya Kasuke Residence Gate
The red brick gate was built in Meiji period. It is registered as National tangible cultural property. Kasuke was the first to import dynamite for industrial usage.

23 Myoko-ji Temple (Chikulinzan)
More than 10 stone plates (stupa) from 14-15th centuries can be found.

24 Myoko-ji Temple (Shojozan)
Main hall, the gate marked with the family crest of the lord of Tako domain, and bell tower- historical depth can be sensed in the air.

25 Nichihon-ji Temple (Nakamura Danlin)

26 Community Plaza Tako Town
It is a complex with a concert hall and various meeting rooms. It also exhibits one of the oldest dugout canoes (7.45m) from early Jomon period (5,500 years ago).

27 Myoko-ji Temple (Myoinzan)
On Sunday during the stamp rally event period (9:00-16:00), visitors can see the special exhibit of a wooden Myoken Bodhisattva worshiped as the guardian god of Chiba clan.

28 Road Station Tako Hydrangea Market
"Kitchen Tako" inside of the building has a nice view of Kuriyama River and rice fields.
10,000 Hydrangea flowers bloom along with the riverside promenade.

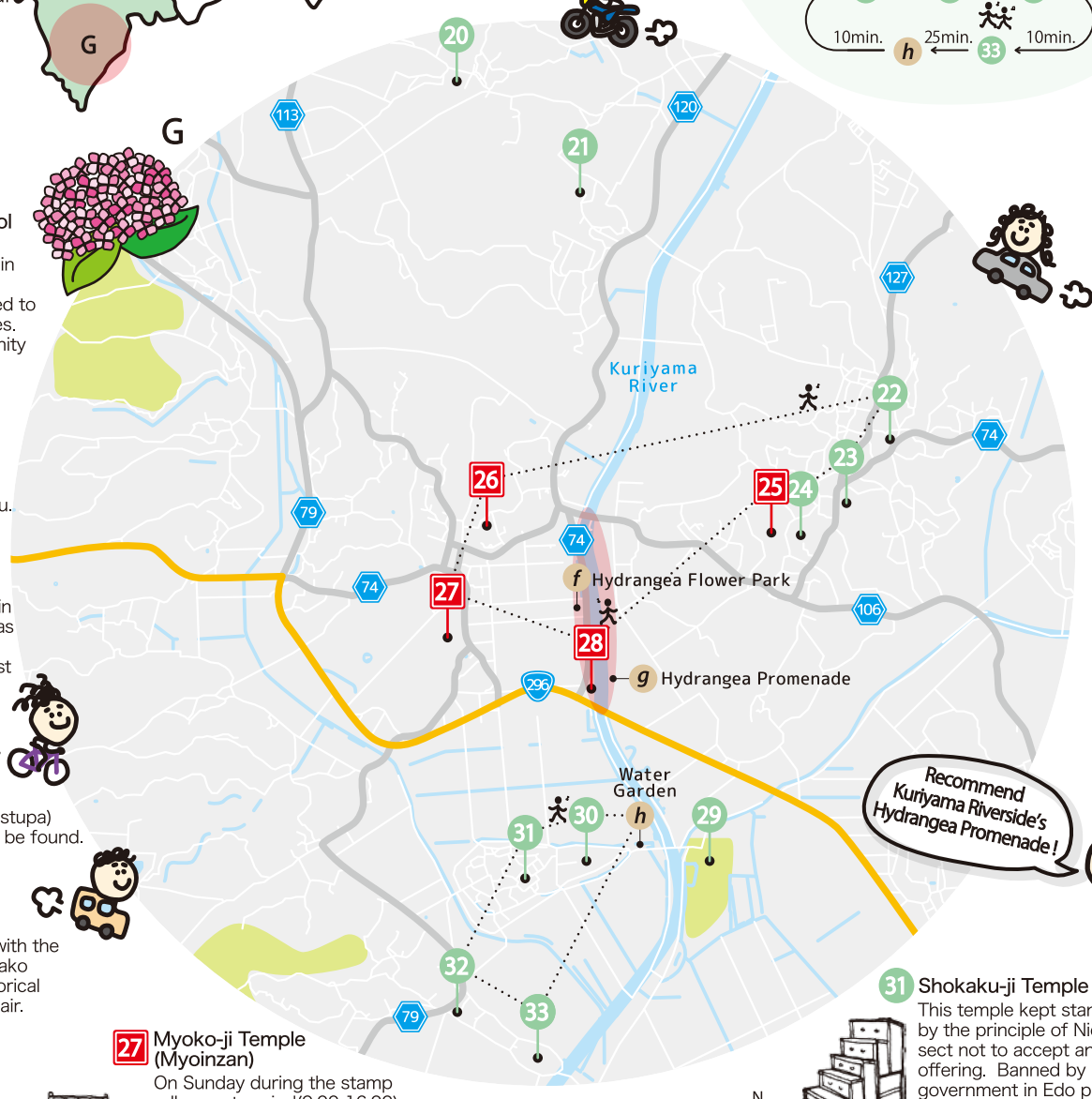
29 Tako Hikari Marshland
Various kinds of rare plants natively grow in the marshland. Hikari marshland is the only habitat in the world for Mujinakugu of Cyperaceae.

30 Site of Shima Castle
Although there is no remain of the castle above ground, various remains of the castle building and moat from 14-15th centuries were found by excavation research.

31 Shokaku-ji Temple
This temple kept standing by the principle of Nichiren sect not to accept any offering. Banned by government in Edo period, people hid in the attic evading from crackdown. A "concealed staircase" is preserved in the main hall.

32 Myoryu-ji Temple
This temple is known for its divine favor for suppressing convulsive fit or baby crying at night time.

33 Mt. Maruyama & Maruyama Shrine
32m-high Maruyama is the lowest mountain in Chiba prefecture; Maruyama Shrine sits on top.
